February 3, 2026**

The City of Pierre Board of Commissioners met in Regular Session on February 3, 2026, with Commissioners Huizenga, Johnson, Reitzel, Lerseth, and Mayor Harding present for roll call. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited followed by an invocation. The agenda was approved as posted.

Karen Perry spoke on behalf of Christine Schreiber to thank Teresa from the Utility Finance office with her assistance to get an old debt removed from her utility bill and want it on record that the \$81 payment be applied to her current utility bill and show the return of the \$100 deposit.

Emeline Post, City Planner, presented Resolution 2807 for the Plat of Lot 5R, Bernie's Replat, on behalf of Gene and Danielle Campbell. Post explained this replat located at 750 W 2nd Street, west of LaBarge Park near Jefferson Elementary, proposes to combine their existing lot with Lot 3 of Huizenga Acres to create Lot 5R. The new lot would resolve the outstanding nonconforming parcel, and the existing house would continue to meet setback requirements. City Planning Commission recommended approval at their January 26th meeting. Commissioner Huizenga moved and Commissioner Johnson seconded to approve Resolution 2807 for the Plat of Lot 5R, Bernie's Replat as presented. Unanimous approval.

BE IT RESOLVED that the City Commission, in and for the City of Pierre, does hereby approve the said plat of Lot 5R, Bernie's Replat, City of Pierre, Hughes County, South Dakota.
