Aaron Swan and Jim Goodman presented a donation for a new Flag Pole and light at Hyde Stadium.

Jeff Runyan, Construction & Operations Manager, presented a professional services agreement with DGR Engineering for the Septic Receiving Station project. The Station will be located at the Baling facility

to allow for septic haulers to weigh the loads with the scale and be billed for actual amounts dumped. The location also allows for the removal of solids before the waste enters the system and allows for dilution between the dump and the treatment plant. Currently haulers dump at the head of the Wastewater Treatment Plant and this doesn't allow for the loads to be weighed, for the solids to be removed or for the waste to be diluted before it goes in the treatment process. The project is scheduled to go to Bid in June 2022 with project completion in November 2022. Commissioner Huizenga moved and Commissioner Barringer seconded to approve the professional services agreement with DGR for not to exceed \$31,972. Unanimous approval.

Nick Waters, Staff Engineer, presented the Outdoor Pool Project Earthwork Change Order #1 for a reduction of \$122,110.08. The change includes several line items and extends time for removal of surcharge to June 3rd. Commissioner Todd Johnson moved and Commissioner Vona Johnson seconded to approve the Outdoor Pool Project Earthwork Change Order #1 for a reduction of \$122,110.08. Unanimous approval.

Twila Hight, Finance Officer, presented the 2022-2023 Malt Beverage License Renewals. There are no changes from the prior year, but 2 are in new names – Quest Casino and Oahe Softball. Police Chief Jason Jones commented that he has no issues with the renewal list. Commissioner Todd Johnson moved and Commissioner Barringer seconded to approve the 2022-2023 Malt Beverage License Renewals. Unanimous approval.
