The dessert classic was changed from a 3 day tournament to a 2 day tournament. I have been meeting with the people at square with issues we have had with our booking system and our reporting system. The tournament schedule has been going well. Junior golf has been going well as well. Our next session starts next week. I did add a camera in our cart shed that shows all of our rentals. Talked about 7-day tournament deadline, to open up spots for non-tournament players to book a tee time during tournament.

We have had one issue with an underage kid driving a personal cart. We just need to figure out if we are going to allow that or not. We might make a parent sign off on the allowable use for personal carts.

We are seeing a lot of cigar burns on the greens as well. I am also going to start providing the rainfall by month. Right now we are running behind the average for rainfall but I think the course is still looking pretty green.
