PIERRE, SOUTH DAKOTA
August 9, 2022**

The City of Pierre board of Commissioners met in regular session on August 9, 2022 with Commissioners Barringer, Huizenga, Todd Johnson, Vona Johnson, and Mayor Harding present for roll call. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited followed by an invocation. The agenda was approved as posted. No one was present for public comment.

Commissioner Barringer moved and Commissioner Todd Johnson seconded to approve the consent calendar to include the Minutes from the Regular Meeting on August 2, 2022; New Hire Water Department Seasonal – Jerry Rada \$25; Raffle Request – 5th Annual Lake Sharpe Bowfishing Tournament; Claims. Brad Palmer, Utilities Director, presented the bids received for the 2023 Electric Materials and the recommendation from DGR Engineering to award to low bidder for each schedule. There were no bids received for single phase transformers, so they will look to see if there is any availability and negotiate accordingly. All bids noted that bids are subject to metals escalation or de-escalation, so total cost of all contracts will be subject to metals cost at the time of shipment. Commissioner Barringer moved and Commissioner Todd Johnson seconded to award the bid for 15kv Primary Power Cable to Dakota Supply Group for \$77,750.10. Unanimous approval. Other bids were received from WESCO for \$113,100 and Border States for \$131,100. Commissioner Barringer moved and Commissioner Todd Johnson seconded to award the bid for 3-phase padmount distribution transformers to RESCO for \$220,816. Unanimous approval. Other bids were received from Dakota Supply Group for \$273,399.99 and WESCO for \$334,366. Commissioner Barringer moved and Commissioner Todd Johnson seconded to award the bid for padmount primary metering cabinet to Border States for \$35,200. Unanimous approval. Other bids were received from Dakota Supply Group for \$35,565.34 and RESCO for \$37,909.95.

Sara Brusseau and Robert Rattling Leaf requested the closure of the 200 block of east Pleasant on August 20th from 4pm to 12am for the 16th annual pre-mustang rally. They will have games, prizes, cars on display, burn outs, and food trucks. Commissioner Vona Johnson moved and Commissioner Barringer seconded to approve the street closure request as presented. Unanimous approval.

Val Keller, Solid Waste Manager, presented a request to surplus and sell the 1974 Terex Scrapper. The scraper will be sold by sealed bids. The new replacement scraper has been delivered and is in service. Commissioner Huizenga moved and Commissioner Vona Johnson seconded to approve the request to surplus and sell by sealed bid the 1974 Terex Scrapper. Unanimous approval.

Val Keller, Solid Waste Manager, presented an update to the garbage pickup schedule explaining that the times will be earlier due to increase efficiency in the pickup schedule. All city collection garbage bags should be placed by 6am to avoid being missed on pickup day.

Sharon Pruess, City Planner, presented a petition to vacate a portion of Chapelle Street and set a hearing for August 30th. The vacation is part of the old City Hall property development project. Once vacated, equal parts of the street will be granted to the property owners on either side of the street. Hegg properties own a portion on the east side that was formerly PryntComm and the City of Pierre owns the property on the west side and the remaining property on the east side. Commissioner Huizenga moved and Commissioner Vona Johnson seconded to accept the petition to vacate a portion of Chapelle Street and set a public hearing for 5:45pm on August 30th. Unanimous approval.

Twila Hight, Finance Officer, presented a request to surplus a 2012 bobcat skid steer from the Electric Department. The unit would be sold on purple wave and the replacement has been received. Commissioner Barringer moved and Commissioner Todd Johnson seconded to approve the request to surplus the 2012 Bobcat Skid steer from the Electric Department. Unanimous approval.

CITY COMMISSION PROCEEDINGS August 9, 2022

Rhea Waldman, SD Discovery Center Executive Director, presented the 3 year renewal building lease. There were minor changes to the language to include an annual report of operations and continued lease of the red Chevrolet impala. Commissioner Todd Johnson moved and Commissioner Vona Johnson seconded to approve the Building Lease Renewal with the SD Discovery Center as presented. Unanimous approval.

2023 Budget Requests were presented by SD Discovery Center, Capital City Band, Capital Area Counseling, and Boys & Girls Club.

Commissioner Vona Johnson moved and Commissioner Huizenga seconded to adjourn. 6:29 p.m. Unanimous approval.
