

Golf Board Meeting

November 2, 2020

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 by Chairman Mike Bartlett in the Training room in City Hall. Attending the meeting were Carin Hayn, Bryan Tipton, Seanna Regynski, Scott Bothun, Hallie Getz, and Mike Bartlett. Tom Farnsworth, Boyd Conzemius, Vona Johnson, Michael Keeton, and Kristy Hight were excused.

A motion was made to approve the minutes from the October 5th meeting by Regynski and seconded by Bothun, motion carried.

Bartlett started the meeting by thanking Bill Gordon for his time to serve on the committee and welcomed Hallie Getz to replace him.

Staff Reports:

Carin Hayn, PGA Professional, clubhouse manager: Hayn gave brief overview since last meeting. Items highlighted below:

- October was a tale of two different types of weather.
- 92 players were able to participate in the Chamber tournament on October 8th.
- The annual Honker tournament has been postponed, but hoping to play Saturday, November 7th. There are 30 teams signed up.
- There was another hole-in-one recorded by Jeff Hallem, bringing the total to 12 for the season.

Hayn went over the rounds and revenue reports for October. Total rounds in October were 1,880, bringing the year to date total to 28,580. This October had 560 more rounds than last October. Revenues through October were \$562,400. This is ahead of where revenues were at in October of 2019, which was \$545,576.

Brian Tiptop, Superintendent: Tipton began by mentioning the great weather that we have had up until the last couple of weeks. He was able to aerate the greens after the Chamber Tournament. After the snow, they were not able to get out and mow for 16 days. They were able to blow out the irrigation system at the end of October before the cold weather set in. This past weekend, they cleaned up a lot of leaves, mowed the greens, and rolled them. Tipton also gave an update on the bridge, which the estimate is just under \$2,000.

Bartlett asked for a rough estimate on a close date. Hayn stated that the close date is looking to be November 12th. Tipton said that his team will be able to aerate the fairways after closing.

Seanna Regynski, HLGA: Regynski stated that the HLGA held their annual awards banquet and were able to get everyone's award paid out. Heidi Ruch was appointed to President, Deanne Booth was appointed to Vice President, and Mandy Hossle will stay the Secretary for next season.

Bartlett brought up talking about possible fee increases for the 2021 season at the December meeting.

Meeting adjourned at 6:00 PM.
