Residential Electronic Recycling

Residential electronic devices can be recycled at Pierre's Solid Waste Facility. Residential Electronics can also be disposed of in residential waste receptacles, however they won't be recycled.

Commercial Electronic Recycling

As mandated by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, non-residential users are required to recycle electronic equipment. Non-recycled electronic commercial equipment can not be accepted by solid waste facilities; federal regulation considers commercial electronics a hazardous waste.

- 4' x 4' wood pallets (good condition only)
