Section 10-6-101 License required.

All electricians doing work within the City of Pierre will be required to be licensed by the City of Pierre. Each person upon paying the license fee as provided herein shall be issued a City of Pierre license upon furnishing satisfactory proof that he is licensed by the State of South Dakota pursuant to passing an examination.

Section 10-6-102 Fees for electrical licenses.

The amount of license fee shall be set out in a scheduled to be approved by the City Commission, as presented and on file at the city business office.

All license fees as provided in this chapter shall be payable to the City Finance Officer who shall issue the license and shall be credited by him to the general fund. All licenses are issued for the
