

# Golf Course Rules and Regulations

## General

- ALL PLAYERS MUST REGISTER IN THE GOLF SHOP BEFORE PLAY. Green fee players must keep the receipt until their round is completed.
- All players will start on Hole #1 unless otherwise directed by golf shop staff. Players coming off the #9 green have priority on the #10 tee box. Holes must be played in order.
- City Ordinance Section 8-1-116: Prohibits any Alcoholic beverage on the Golf Course except those purchased on the premises.
- Golf Course personnel will monitor the golf course.
  - All players are expected to maintain the pace of play and treat other players with respect. Slower players may be asked to allow faster players to play through.
  - Practicing on the course or greens is not allowed.
  - Players are required to care for the golf course by repairing divots and ball marks, raking bunkers, and following golf cart rules.
  - No sunflower seeds are allowed.
  - Vandalism of golf greens, the course, and golf carts is strictly prohibited.
- Players must wear golf shoes with soft spikes or tennis shoes.
- All players must have their own set of clubs. Clubs are available for rent in the Golf Shop.
- Range equipment/practice balls are the property of the golf course. They are not to be removed from the property or used on the golf course during play.
- Keep golf bags and push/pull carts off of putting surfaces.
- In case of threatening weather, a warning siren will sound. All players must leave the course and take shelter. Course restrooms are not safe shelter areas during lightning storms.
- Starting times may be made three weeks in advance by members and one week in advance by non-members, either online by accessing [www.cityofpierre.org](http://www.cityofpierre.org) or by calling the golf shop at 773-6191.
- Golf Shop personnel will combine groups who are less than 4 together during busy times on the golf course to allow for a better flow of play and optimum use for all players.

## Golf Cart Use

- Use the 90-degree rule whenever possible and keep carts on the path around greens and tees.
- Due to golf course conditions, more strict golf cart use rules may be in place. Players are required to follow all cart rules posted each day.
- Players who have a physical disability may be issued a blue flag for their cart and be required to follow the guidelines set forth for the use of a handicap flag.
- Only two people may ride in each cart.
- Drivers must be 14 years or older and have a valid driver's license to operate golf carts.

## Season Rental Cart Plan

- The season rental cart plan is for the purchaser only. Any guest or additional rider in the cart must also pay for the cart's use. If a family rental cart plan has been purchased, your spouse and dependent children may ride in the cart at no additional charge.
